Chairperson Jackie N Williams announced that the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (KS•CPOST) today denied the petition of Mark Koehn for the reinstatement of his law enforcement certification. Mr. Koehn surrendered his law enforcement certification in October of 2000 as part of a plea agreement when he was convicted of vehicular homicide arising from his duties as a deputy sheriff in Kiowa County.

The Kansas Commission *on* Peace Officers' Standards *and* Training (KS•CPOST), a 12-member body appointed by the Governor, oversees law enforcement training and officer standards in the State of Kansas. Among its many duties and responsibilities is that of regulating the certifications of all Kansas full and part-time officers.
