The public KS-CPOST Commission meeting was held via teleconference and was called to order by Chairman John Whitmer with a roll call of commissioners in attendance, along with KS-CPOST and KLETC staff as listed above.

A motion (2017 M 10) was made by Commissioner Jones to deny the formal request from Rawlins County Sheriff Ken Higley for a waiver pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5622(a)(3) to reinstate his lapsed certification as a law enforcement officer. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Powell and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Whitmer made the motion (2017 M 09) that, pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, the Commission delegates its authority to the Hearing Committee on all matters in any

case that has been investigated but not finalized by the Commission's Investigative Committee for an alleged violation of the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Act or regulations promulgated by the Commission; such delegation includes, but is not limited to, conducting proceedings and hearings, issuing orders pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616 and K.S.A. 74-5605, and amendments thereto, deciding requests for reconsideration or requests for a stay, determining appeals or settlements, considering reinstatement pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5622, and amendments thereto, or any other matters related thereto unless the Hearing Committee determines the matter should be considered by the full Commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Fleming and passed unanimously.

Upon motion (2017 M 11) made by Commissioner Herrig and seconded by Commissioner Fleming, the meeting was adjourned at 3:23 pm by a unanimous approval.
